



What does the Campus Health Center offer in the way of women's health care?

The Campus Health Center provides comprehensive women's health care at low cost to the patient, in a friendly and confidential atmosphere. Insured students are given regular pap smears and pay minimally for other services or prescriptions. Routine gynecological exams are important to prevent disease, to provide for early detection of cancers of the cervix and breast, and to detect sexually transmitted infections. They also can promote uncomplicated pregnancies and prevent sterility.

How often should I have a pap smear or exam?

You should have a routine GYN exam either yearly or as directed by your provider. Of course if you are having discomfort, abnormal bleeding, breast changes, or have any concerns you should come in promptly.
